Deficit of Tech Athletic Fund To Be Raised

The Athletic Association of the Texas Technological college is in need of \$3700 with which to pay the expenses of the season, and the liberality of the people of Lubbock is the only source from which this amount can be drawn.

Students attending the college have already given to the hurting point in order to finance athletics thus far, they having given \$1700 in cash over to the treasury of the Athletic Association, which with the \$2200 that has been given by people not residents of Lubbock cuts the deficit to \$3700, the amount which is asked at the hands of the people of Lubbock.

Lubbock business men who are interested in the future of the college and who realize fully the value of a

well balanced athletic program to the general good of the college, will this week institute a campaign to raise the \$3700 that is needed.

Carter Will Give \$2500 In Cash
