

New York Mayor Not Coming By Special Flight

Mr. William O'Dwyer, Mayor of New York and Mrs. O'Dwyer who were scheduled to arrive in Trinidad aboard Pan American World Airways giant strato-cruiser, "El Presidente" on its pre-inaugural flight tonight will not be on board, the "Evening News" was informed this morning.

Other prominent personalities who were unable to make the flight in the "queen of the skies" were Mr. Hugh Baillie, president of United Press Association; Mr. Roy Howard, editor of Scripps-Howard; Mr. Henry Luce, editor of Time-Life and Fortune, Mrs. Clare Booth Luce, author, journalist, artist and former United States Congresswoman, Mr. Marshall Fields, editor of Chicago Sun Times, Mr. Paul Peterson, director of Baltimore Sun, Mr. Charles McCabe, director of New York Mirror, and Mrs. Holby.

The aircraft is scheduled to arrive at Piarco airport at 8.15 tonight from New York and after a brief pause, will take off for Rio de Janeiro, Montevideo, Buenos Aires and will return on its return trip to New York for a whole day stay at Piarco on July 5.
