Mr. Byrne is a general contractor, and has constructed all the buildings with which Mr. Carter has been identified, including the Star-Telegram, Radio Station WBAP-TV, Y.M.C.A. Camp, Greater Fort Worth-International Airport, wing on the St. Joseph's Hospital, St. Joseph's Hospital School of Nursing Home, Fort Worth Academy of Medicine, and so on.
