I am sending you under separate express one small head made from the statue that Electra made of Will, which I hope you like. There were four of these heads: one for my home, one for the office, one for LO-G at the Fort Worth Club and the other I am sending to you.

I am hastily writing this letter just before leaving for New York by plane and therefore I shall be unable to sign it so will ask Mrs. Deakins to sign this when she writes the letter.

Meantime, due to the fact that I am going to be out of the state for an indefinite time, it will be impossible to dedicate the statue on November 4th. The foundation is being arranged for and all plans as I hope to be back by the middle of November and we will try and work out plans for the middle of November or the early part of December to suit your convenience.
