MOODY CHEERS CAUSE OUSTING

Publisher Chased from
Grid Game at College
Station.

Houston, Tex., Nov. 27 (AP).—
Amon G. Carter, prominent news-
paper publisher of Fort Worth, to-
day related how he was escorted
from the football field at College
Station yesterday when he cheered
too vociferously for Attorney Gen-
eral Dan Moody while standing near
the box occupied by Governor
Miriam A. Ferguson and her party.

The escorting was done by one of
Governor Ferguson's "colonels" who
permitted Mr. Carter to return im-
mediately to the field when he made
it plain that he had meant no dis-
courtesy to the governor's party.

"I was cheering for the Texas
Aggies and enthusiastically added a
vocal panegyric for Mr. Moody," Mr.
Carter said. "I did not know I was
near the box occupied by the execu-
tive party. I was directing my cries
at the crowd and not at the gover-
nor's box."
