Dear Amon:


This is merely to say that I join with your legion of friends who rejoice with you in the news you have received about Amon, Jr.

Former Senator Herring of Iowa, who is our next door neighbor here in the Mayflower Hotel, has just had a similar experience. His son was reported missing from the same area at about the same time that your boy disappeared. The day before yesterday, he received the glad tidings that his son also was a prisoner of war in Germany and in good health.

I just wanted you to know that I have shared your apprehension and feel at least some small sense of the gratification which the good news must have brought you.
