Mimir Chamber Music Festival concerts return to campus next week

TOP CLASSICAL MUSICIANS FROM North America, joined by the talents of acclaimed Swedish brothers making their third trip to North Texas in as many years, are the focus of TCU's annual Mimir Chamber Music Festival July 10-15.

The ensemble will present three evening concerts during the week and, individually, serve as daytime instructors and coaches to 20 student musicians who are coming to campus from across the country to refine their classical skills. This event is the only chamber music festival of its kind in this region of the country.

Curt Thompson, TCU violin professor and founder of the Mimir festival, has assembled professional artists from the Chicago Symphony, Cleveland Orchestra, Montreal Symphony and Berlin Hochschule fuer Music to serve as faculty. Grammy Award-nominee clarinetist Martin Fröst and his brother, pianist Johann Fröst, also will serve as guest

artists/faculty and represent the musical traditions of Sweden at the festival. (The name "Mimir" is taken from the god of wisdom in Norse mythology.)

"Chamber music is a way for musicians used to blending into a large orchestra to shine as soloists, and for listeners to get to know the 'character' musicians create through their performances," according to Curt. "Experiencing this genre is crucial to the development of young musicians."

The public concerts will be at 8 p.m. July 11, 13 and 14 in PepsiCo Recital Hall. Tickets are \$15 at the door (\$10 for faculty, staff, students and seniors). Children under 10 will not be admitted. A free chamber music concert featuring the student participants in the Mimir Festival is set for 2 p.m. July 15 in PepsiCo Recital Hall.

Survivor "ex-tribesman" is staffer Mary Lane's nephew

THAT THURSDAY MORNING REHASH OF the previous night's *Survivor* t.v. episode has special meaning to **Mary Lane**, administrative assistant for the School of Education. The popular CBS summer series

has featured her nephew, Dirk Been, who was voted off the island last week.

The 23-year-old grew up on a Wisconsin dairy farm, son of Mary's brother, Bill Been. Dirk is a youth minister who was between jobs when he was selected to do the show last spring, Mary explains.

Filming took place in March and April on the island of Pulau Tiga off the coast of Borneo in the South China Sea. During each week's episode one "tribesman" is eliminated by group vote until one person remains and wins \$1 million.

Dirk and the rest are legally bound to maintain secrecy about the series' outcome, so he has shared no inside information with his family except as the episodes unfold. "I'm eager to talk to him and find out what really happened," says Mary. "Dirk has told us that situations aren't always the way they seem on t.v."
