I have been very busy traveling all over Mexico and Cuba, because of the inauguration of new air -- lines. This is the reason for not answering your kind ---- letter of September 30th.


We were very proud to receive the visit of good first class Americans as your goodself for the --- inauguration of American Airlines Service.
