Dear Mr. Carter:

From the "Ft. Worth Star-Telegram" of March 21, I learned that your son, Lt. Carter, had written you that my husband Captain Steffen of Huntsville was on his way to the same prison camp in Poland. Your secretary was kind enough to send me the address with some instructions of how I could write to my husband, but the Postmaster here says that the rules say that under no condition shall a person write to one in a German prison camp unless official word and the Prisoner of War number has been received.

I have not received word from the Government nor the Prisoner of War number and am very anxious to let my husband know that I know where he is. If you have the space in your next letter to Lt. Carter, I would appreciate it so very much if you would ask him to tell Captain Steffen that his wife knows where he is and all is well at home.

I sincerely appreciate getting the news of my husband from Lt. Carter.
