Yesterday Mr. Carter received a letter from his son dated October 10 which is his last letter from Amon, although others have received mail dated as late as December 10 and from all indications they are getting along all right, but a little despondent that the war has not ended. Amon said in this letter that it would be late spring at least before they would be out. Of course, it could be sooner and it could be later.

Any time you have any information from your husband, we shall be glad to have it and likewise will be glad to pass anything of interest along to you.
