Carter Denies 90
Garner Backers
Anti-Roosevelt

FORT WORTH, April 29. (U.P.)—Amon G. Carter, Fort Worth newspaper publisher, wrote Secretary of Interior Ickes today denying that Texas supporters of John Garner are "anti-Roosevelt."

Ickes last week criticized Carter for implying in editorials that he, Ickes, was a "carpet-bagger," attempting to interfere with the Texas support of vice-president. He charged that Garner movement was solely a "stop Roosevelt affair."

"This is a misstatement entirely disproved by facts," Carter replied. "No one has a greater personal respect for President Roosevelt than I have. Garner being the only full-fledged candidate at this time, we are supporting him on his qualifications. For this we have no apology."
