

Bothwell Is Named on Midway Airport's Board

Appointment of City Manager Bothwell to represent Fort Worth on the board of managers for Midway Airport was announced Wednesday by William Holden, executive vice president of the Fort Worth Chamber of Commerce.

The Chamber of Commerce executive said he was writing T. E. Braniff, president of the Midway Airport Association, advising him of the action.

Braniff requested Fort Worth to name a representative on the airport board in a letter written Sept. 7 to R. Mayo Bowen, president of the Fort Worth chamber. His let-

ter pointed out that the association's contract for operation of the airport provided that the management board at all times should include one appointee of the city of Arlington, one member named by the president of the Dallas Chamber of Commerce, one appointed by the president of the Fort Worth chamber, and four appointees of the corporation, which is owned jointly by Braniff Airways and American Airlines.

Mayor W. F. Altman of Arlington said the city council there had instructed him to serve as Arlington's representative on the airport board "until further notice."
