Dear Mr. Carter,

Your welcome telegram yesterday confirmed an item I read in a paper on Thursday that Arnon had been reported a prisoner of the Germans. You can be assured of my great relief on receiving your message and share with you your happiness and thankfulness that nothing worse had befallen him. I think you can safely assume that he will be reasonably well treated as there are many German prisoners on whom it is true that some can be retaliated. I hope an exchange of prisoners can be effected later that will see him and others restored to the American forces.

Even though I am unable to
do any thing I wish I might be
able to assist you in some way.

Your many kindnesses to me
and the other officers and
especially to Mrs. Summrell
are among the brightest
spots of the past year. If I
can be of service in anyway
please let me know.

Mrs. Summrell joins
me in warm regards.
