Houston Officer In Nazi Camp With Amon Carter Jr.

FORT WORTH, April 30.—(AP)—Amon G. Carter, Fort Worth publisher, learned Friday that his son, Lieut. Amon Carter Jr., now a prisoner in Germany, hid for nine days behind the central Tunisian German lines before his capture.

In a letter to his father, Lieutenant Carter, an artillery officer, reported missing in action Feb. 14 near Sbeitla, said he was captured by the Germans Feb. 23, flown out of Africa to Italy, then put on a train and taken into Germany.

With him in his present camp, he said, are three other Texans—Lieuts. George Beazley of Ennis, Ed Batte of Waxahachie and John T. Jones Jr. of Houston.

His letter reported good treatment.
