

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, The United States War Department recently has reported that Amon G. Carter, Jr., First Lieutenant in the American Army operating in North Africa, was captured and is now a prisoner of war in Germany; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Amon G. Carter, Jr., son of a distinguished Texas citizen was among the first to enter the armed service in defense of Democracy and American ideals, and proved his willingness to undergo any sacrifice to maintain these great principles; and

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Carter is an outstanding type of young American and Texas manhood, upon which depends the future of this country and civilization itself; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the Texas Legislature extend to the father, Amon G. Carter, Sr., of Fort Worth, Texas, its deep sympathy, and, at the same time, congratulations for the heroic participation of his son in the North African campaign to drive out the Axis forces; and be it further
