down in Alabama but I was unable to
to go any farther than here - the house of
Mr Ely Petty and his wife where I have
been as kindly treated as I could desire for
the four weeks that I have been here I have
also had a Dr Harris attending on me for
nothing but he has taken as good care of me
if he were going to get a regular fee - I have
also been visited by a Dr Ripito an agent
for the State of Texas to distribute money to
the needy Texan Soldiers he gave me \$20.00
Confederate Note this is the first I have received
since I left home and it was gladly recd
as I had been entirely out for some time.

I will possibly not be able to leave here in a
week or two yet as my wound is not yet healed
go back to next page

and do not know what regmt I will join
but expect I will join Col Whartons
Cavalry as it is the only ~~Regt~~ as Regmt
I know of any where about here
I will write to you as soon as I
locate myself if I should stop
any length of time at any place
I wish you to write to me but until
I let you know that I am located for
some time it will be use less to write
I have delayed writing till now because I
wanted to know that I was improving before
I wrote
